



## CLUB SWAN 42 TUNING GUIDE, Developed by NORTH SAILS, *updated August 2, 2007*

### **Sailing Notes**

- Use the late main Gybe in winds over 20 vt. bear away until kite can be gybed. Hold DDW until next wave and let main float across...possible give it a quick assist to come across.
- Target Speeds and angles from Ockam are very good 80% of the time. If they are off it's because something is changing like a header coming or an extreme gradient.
- Gybe inside until 16 vt. Outside above 16 vt.
- Traveler is not great as supplied. A better set-up is with a ratchet block and 4/1 purchase.
- The boat hook is a must have item.
- A2 goes down remarkably low. We found it ok down to 9 vt. same as in KW.
- Downwind in light air 7-11 vt: best to have 4 people in front of shrouds to windward with flat boat with Stysl.
- Stysl range is down to 7 vt and above.
